I have great pleasure in presenting the annual report of the academic year 2025-26. Vision without action is merely a dream. St Jude aims to be a centre of excellence in academic and cultural aspects. It is with this vision that we sow the seeds of knowledge and mould our students to the best of their potentials.

Outstanding CBSE results ushered in immense cheer at the commencement of the academic year. In the Std XII board exam Siya Paul secured 94.8% in Bio / Maths stream. Krishnapriya A R secured 94.6 % in Computer/ Maths and Mariam Chinnan V secured 92.8 % in Commerce. In STD X board exam results Angelina Gipson scored 97.4% and Riya Paul scored 97.2%.

It is the persistent efforts of our tenacious teachers which has helped the students to exhibit exemplary results.

The new academic year commenced on June 2nd with a rousing reception to our enthusiastic learners and with a prayer session. The tiny tots of LKG were initiated to the world of letters in a Vidyarambham ceremony by Rev. Fr Franson Kurisingal .The school leaders were elected and vested with positions in an Investiture ceremony. Ebin Binu of STD XI and Jesse Jose of STD IX were elected as school leaders.The school election gave an opportunity for the students to choose the right person which will further enhance their decision making skills. Ethan Alby of Std VIII, Al Rayan of Std IX, Itihas P of Std IX, Anav Dixon of Std IX were also pledged in as House Captains .
